What's the need?

There are 8¹/₂ million Anglicans in Uganda, over a third of the population. By all appearances the Church is thriving. But according to Operation World this is offset by: "widespread polygamy, a culture of promiscuity and paying mere lip-service to God." There is great need for Uganda's often superficial Christianity to be deepened through mature godly leadership, Biblical teaching and renewal.

Uganda Christian University is working towards this goal by training Christians for leadership in all spheres of society. Dan and Rosie fill a need in the Theology Department and add to the multi-cultural staff team. They bring enrichment to the college through their international experience and education.

Why Dan and Rosie?

At 16 Dan's values and ambitions were radically transformed by a short-term mission to Mexico. His passion for the unreached grew during two years in Kenya doing church planting and pastoral work. During Dan's Masters studies, he spent one term at All Nations Christian College where he met Rosie.

Rosie came from a Christian family and made a personal commitment in her teens. After her Theology degree, PGCE and teaching Religious Education in the UK, Rosie went to Zambia to teach. Following an MA at All Nations, Rosie went to Harare, Zimbabwe. After the first year Dan and Rosie married and they stayed for a further four years' teaching at two theological colleges. They were also involved in college administration, pastoral work, preaching and church leadership.

Now Dan:

- Teaches Theology and Biblical studies
- Is chaplain of a student group with pastoral responsibilities
- Does administration for the university
- Preaches in the chapel

Dan hopes to start part-time PhD research and to encourage practical training for missions both within and from Africa.

Rosie is involved in:

- Teaching Biblical subjects
- Supporting and leading student groups.
- Sourcing books for the library and students.
- Providing input into the campus Sunday School
- Building relationships with mums through her children.
