About Crosslinks camps

Crosslinks camps offer a fantastic opportunity for children and young people to spend time in God's word, thinking through mission and God's plan for his world. The camps are full of activities, Bible talks and visits by our mission partners.

Crosslinks camps provide young people with the opportunity to explore life with Jesus – whether someone is considering that for the first time or is wanting to grow in and explore their faith.

Who's in charge?

Our leaders come from all walks of life across the UK and Ireland, from students to retirees. Each of them is linked with and recommended by their church, and provided with the necessary training. All leaders are committed Christians who are living out their faith through a Christ-like lifestyle.

We use the AccessNI and Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) as part of our safe recruitment policy. Each camp also has directors appointed by and accountable to Crosslinks. Each camp has a safeguarding officer, first-aider and lifeguards (if swimming is available as a camp activity). We ensure that all aspects of Crosslinks camps follow the current standards and policies set by the Safeguarding Trust.

Who do I talk to about my child's needs?

We do everything we can to cater for all children's needs — whether dietary, physical or anything else. All we ask is that, at the time of booking, you let Crosslinks know about any particular need. If you do not let us know in good time, we may not be able to provide the appropriate care your child would require at camp.

What does the price of camp include?

The cost of camp will cover accommodation, all meals and all activities during the week. Parents/guardians are responsible for travel arrangements to and from camp.
