Crosslinks exists to help people get involved in God's mission to take God's word to God's world. We believe every Christian has a part to play in God's plan for the world. Crosslinks has over 120 workers in more than 40 countries worldwide. Over 90 of these are long-term mission partners sent by churches in the UK and Ireland. We also help indigenous workers run 20 different gospel projects in their home nations and provide bursaries to enable those in less well-off countries to study for ministry. In addition, Crosslinks has a short-term mission programme, sending men and women across the globe to serve alongside our long-term mission partners.

## Help us spread the word

We need your help so that we can keep on welcoming new children and teenagers to camp each year. Here are some ideas for how you can help spread the word.

### 1) Prayer

Are there specific people that you hope will come to camp? Set aside a couple of minutes each day to pray for them. Pray that they would come to know Jesus for themselves or grow in their faith. Pray that the Lord would choose to use Crosslinks camps as a means of drawing these young people closer to him.

If you don't have specific young people in mind, please pray more generally that both Junior and Senior Camp would be fully booked. Pray that the Lord would use each camp to draw campers closer to himself.

### 2) Personal invites

The main reason people come on a Crosslinks camp is because someone recommends it to them. Sharing your experiences of these camps makes a vital contribution to what happens every summer.

### 3) Talking about camps at church

Church services, small groups and youth fellowships are great places to talk about Crosslinks camps. We can provide you with our video and posters as well as

with flyers to give out. Alternatively, you could write something about camp to share on your church website or social media. If you send us a link, we'll share it on ours as well!

You might well be the best person to share your camp experience with your church. If not, could you encourage someone else (whether a leader, camper or parent) to step forward?
